

The Blended Learning Unit



Hands-on in PebblePAD ePortfolio

To assist staff with using PebblePad, the Blended Learning Unit will be offering a series of workshops to explore different aspects of PebblePad. There will be 5 different sessions, each lasting half an hour which span a morning or afternoon. The training topics consist of:

Recording your personal development

The PebblePad tool has scaffolding within it to support and record life long learning, to help students with their learning processes, to act on their feedback more effectively and collect evidence on achievement to enhance employability. This session will demonstrate the various aspects of the system that will add value to your ePDP.

Creating a blog

A blog (or WeBlog) is a type of online journal or diary which can be used for public or private reflection, peer support and collaborative work. This session will explore how blogs can be used with your students and by the end of the session you will have created your own blog.

Creating a WebFolio template for student completion

A WebFolio template is a structured way to ensure your students are submitting the right information, either for formative or summative assessment. This workshop will show you how to create and share a WebFolio for your students to copy and populate.

Sharing, commenting and feedback

Formative assessment is a powerful way to gauge the level of understanding of your students. This session will show how to use PebblePad as a tool for sharing, commenting and feedback which will allow students and staff to engage in (and automatically record) dialogue which can both inform further learning and create a community of practice.

Creating and assessing A Gateway (must have rights)

This session will show how to create a gateway, demonstrate the process students will go through to submit their assessments and also demonstrate how to assess and give feedback through the PebblePad gateway. To undertake this session you must have a minimum of tutor rights on a gateway.
