Hands-on in WOLF

To assist staff with using WOLF, the Blended Learning Unit will be offering a series of workshops to explore different aspects of WOLF. There are 5 different sessions, each lasting half an hour which span a morning or afternoon. The training topics consist of:

Personalisation of WOLF

Working through the 'desktop' window, the session will focus on personalising your profile and communication of WOLF. These basic functions will enable you to use WOLF more effectively, as well as giving you the understanding of how WOLF works.

Structuring and setting your topic

Using the WOLF training topic the facilitator can show you how you can use the settings within the WOLF topic. The structure of the topic and the front 'page' of the topic is as vital as the content itself.

How to create a Forum and WIKI

There are a variety of different methods of creating collaborative tasks within your WOLF topic. The two commonly used are a Forum and WIKI. This demonstration will show you how to create these two topics as well as giving examples and benefits of using these within WOLF.

Creating a formative assessment

Formative assessment is a vital way of assessing your students. WOLF allows you to create and manage formative assessment tasks within your WOLF topic. This session will explore how you can create Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ's) within your WOLF topic.

Submitting and assessing work

Students submitting work to WOLF has been a key aspect of the Blended Learning Strategy, giving the freedom of access to all students to submit their work 24 hours a day. This session will explore how you can create a submission topic, as well as how you assess, grade and give feedback to the students.
